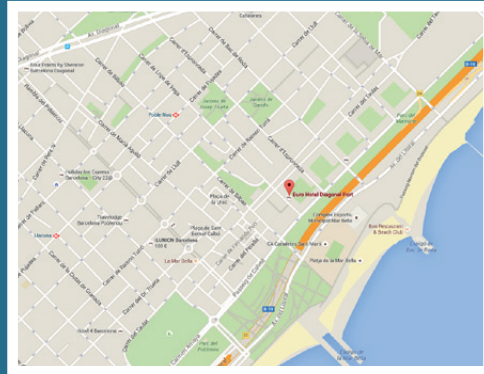

985 Euros (single room)

890 Euros (shared double room: accepted only with the identification of the sharing participant)

740 Euros (without hotel accommodation)

The fee of 985 Euro (single room), or of 890 Euro (shared double room, accepted only with the indication of the sharing participant), includes board and lodging from Friday 11/03/2016 night (dinner included) to Sunday 13/03/2016 morning (informal lunch included), and covers accommodation at the hotel, the meals during the course, the Proceedings and other didactic material. Travel expenses are at the charge of participants. Participants from Barcelona, not needing hotel accommodation (bed and breakfast), will pay a reduced fee of 740 Euro. The course shall be in English. The number of participants is foreseen in 100. In case the number of applications should exceed the number of available places, a selection of applications may be made on the basis of the chronological order of arrival and the judgement of the course coordinators. The course is subject to cancellation owing to causes beyond control, or in the unlikely case that the required minimum number of registrations should not be reached. In this case, a written notification of the cancellation will be sent to all registrants before the course, with full refund. Requests of cancellation received up to 2 months before the beginning of the course entitle to a full refund. A charge of 25% will be made for requests of cancellation received between 60 and 30 days before, and of 50% between 29 days and 10 days before the beginning of the course. Cancellations received less than 10 days before the beginning of the course will not be reimbursed. All requests of cancellation must be done in written, signed and sent by e-mail transmission. All reimbursements will be dealt with after the end of the course.
